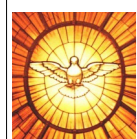

ST CATHERINE OF SIENA (1347—1380) Feast, 29th April



She was a lay woman who lived in a time disrupted by political turmoil, wars, the plague and schism in the Church. It was a difficult time and many people thought the end times were near. Catherine loved the Church as the Bride of Christ. She knew that Christ preserved his Church despite the sins of his chosen ones and she never lost sight of the humanity and weakness of her ministers. She was proclaimed a doctor of the Church by Pope Paul VI and copatron of Europe by Pope John Paul II.
