ST ALBAN
Protomartyr of England
Feast Day: 20th June

Tradition says that St Alban was a Roman soldier at Verulamium. Verulamium is now St. Albans in Hertfordshire. Alban, a pagan, is said to have sheltered a priest who was fleeing persecution. Alban took the priest's cloak and allowed him to escape. Roman soldiers arrested Alban, who was later beheaded. The traditional site of Alban's death, Holmhurst Hill, became the site of St. Alban's Abbey, founded by King Offa in the VIII Century.

Prayer Comes from a Humble Heart
Beloved brethren, let the worshipper not forget how the publican prayed with the Pharisee in the temple—not with his eyes boldly raised up to heaven, nor with hands held up in pride; but beating his breast and confessing his sins within, he implored the help of the divine mercy. While the Pharisee was pleased with himself, it was the Publican who deserved to be sanctified, since he placed his hope of salvation not in his confidence of innocence—since no-one is innocent—but he prayed, humbly confessing his sins, and he who pardons the humble heard his prayer. *St Cyprian (210-258)*
