**TODAY IS THE
SOLEMNITY OF
CHRIST THE
KING**

The Solemnity was instituted by Pope Pius XI in 1925, the sixteenth centenary of the Council of Nicaea, at which the doctrine of the consubstantiality of Christ with the Father was defined. The date marks the end of the liturgical year. The Pope asserted that the most effective defence against the destructive forces of the age is the recognition of the kingship of Christ. Each of us has been anointed with holy oil at baptism, as priest, prophet and king. Today's Solemnity is a good moment to reflect on our kingship. Understanding the feast makes us understand our own call better.

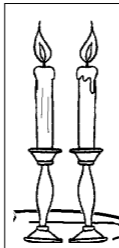
**ST PETER'S SCHOOL

They welcome Christ himself and clothe, by teaching righteousness, those who are naked and even without a garment of righteousness. As is written: "Put on, then, compassion, faith, peace and kindness." That is to say, they clothe Christ and baptize them in Christ, as is written: "For as many of you as were baptized into Christ have put on Christ."
