Today at the 10:00am Mass, we welcome our new communicants and their families. There will be a reception in the hall after Mass. All welcome.

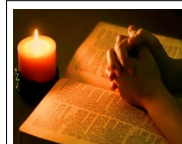

On the day before he suffered he took bread in his holy hands, looked toward heaven, toward you, holy Father omnipotent, eternal God, giving thanks, blessed, broke, and having broken it gave it to the apostles and his disciples," saying: "Take and eat of this, all of you; for this is my body, which shall be broken for many."
