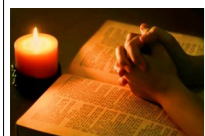

**With Great Power Comes Great Responsibility.** It is pleasant to observe the disciples, lifted up to a height of glory equal to the burden of humility to which they were called.
